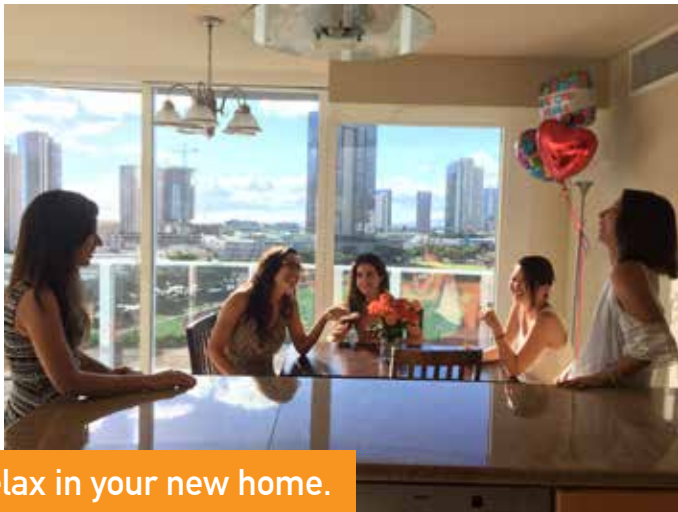


Student Service America provides a variety of support services to international students studying in Hawai'i. When an international student comes to Hawai'i, one of the most difficult issues is housing.

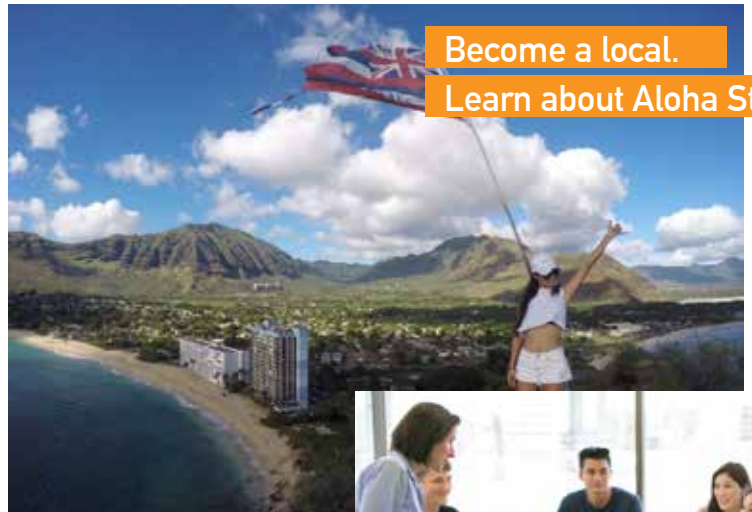

We appreciate the opportunity to support you with Aloha Spirit to ensure that your time in Hawai'i is productive and enjoyable.

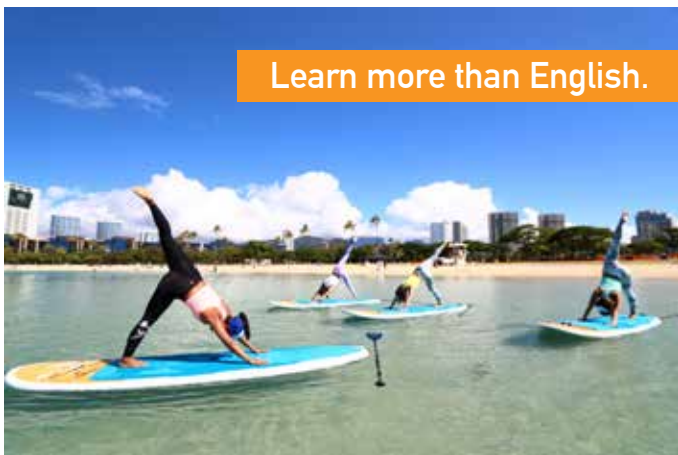

ENGLISH + PROGRAM

What is the ENGLISH + PROGRAM?

Students take an English program in the morning or afternoon at Central Pacific College, which is located in the Ala Moana area. Students will also take a program related to their interests, such as Hula dance, surfing, yoga, etc. Students will not only learn English, but also other skills. This package includes all programs, accommodations and support services.



ENGLISH PROGRAM

Central Pacific College has two main programs for learners of English. The English Proficiency Program (20 hours a week) is for students with a student visa. The Short-Term English Program (16 hours a week) is for visitors on a tourist visa or ESTA. Both program have 8 levels that focus on can-do goals (Listening, Speaking, Reading, Writing, and Grammar).

ACCOMMODATION

Students can choose their accommodation:

- Meals are NOT provided at the student's residence, however, all houses have a kitchen and are well-equipped.

ENGLISH + HULA LESSON

Hui 'O Kamalei

Hui 'O Kamalei have choreographed, dance instruction, with Hawaii and South Pacific Islands such as Tahiti, Samoa and New Zealand. They teach student from ages 3 to 103 years old. They use a variety of songs from Christian songs to the funky Hula. They teach different styles of dance such as Hula, Tahitian, Maori and Samoan Fire-knife.

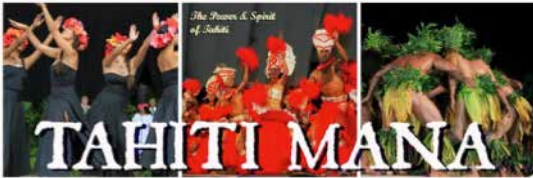

2-Month Weekend Course 200-Hour Yoga Teacher Training

Opportunity for a 2-month weekends program

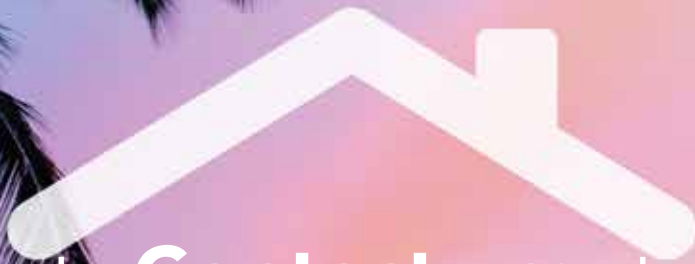
CLUB KEIKI JR.
